

Lola Creek Campground, Idaho

Description: 6600-foot elevation. 21 campsites with a group picnic site are on Marsh Creek, and near Lola Creek. Trailhead from FR 083 up the creek to Lola Lakes. Trail(hiking/horse riding)along Marsh Creek into the Frank Church River of No Return Wilderness to the Middle Fork of the Salmon River. Put-in for whitewater boating or floating the first leg of the wild and scenic river is at the end of the trail. Stalls and stock loading facilities at the trailhead.

Location: From Stanley, go 17 miles northwest on ID 21, then 1 mile northwest on Forest Road 083.

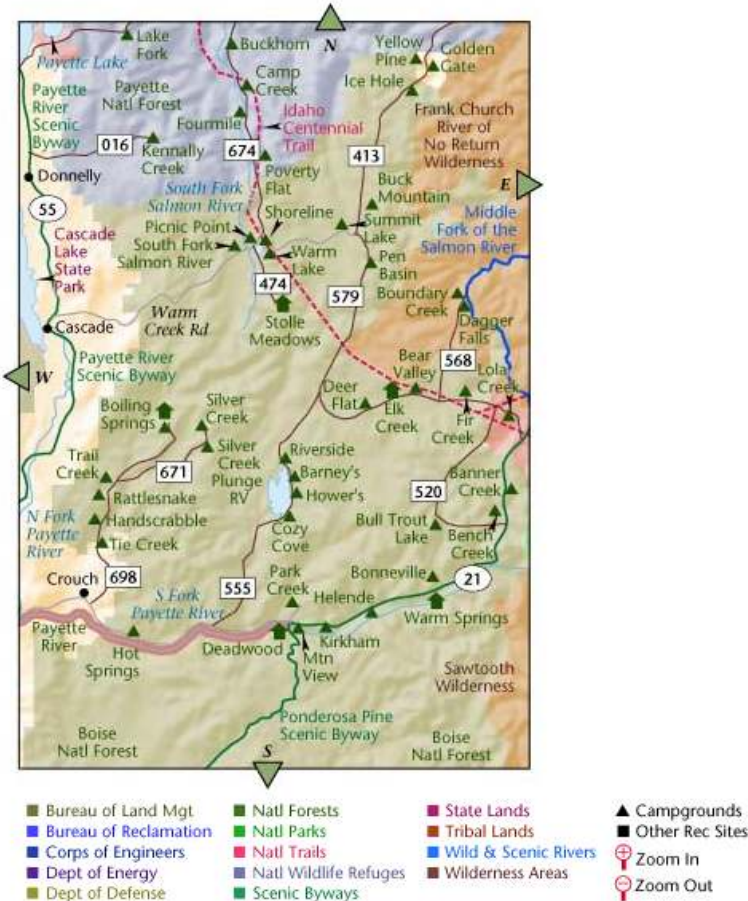
