Description: 6537-foot elevation. 19 campsites on Stanley Lake. Fishing for rainbow and lake trout, swimming and lounging at the beach. Trailhead at Stanley Lake Campground for Idaho Centennial Trail which goes through a lake-filled region of the Sawtooth Wilderness. Boat ramp at Stanley Lake Inlet Campground. Located in a lodgepole pine overstory. Activities include fishing, motorized boating and watersports, sailing, canoeing, swimming, hiking, mountain biking, scenic driving, and wildlife watching.

Location: From Stanley, go 5 miles north on ID 21 then 3.5 miles west on Forest Road 455.
