

Fourth of July Weekend – Crooked River & Beaver Creek

The trail heads for Crooked River and Beaver Creek are 1.1 miles from the Edna Creek Camp ground off highway 21. (GPS N 43 57.334 W 115 36.212) Crooked River Trail heads south and Beaver Creek trends north. The area Phil and I have picked to camp is one mile further up the road on the right (south side). (GPS N 43 57.857 W 115 35.303) It is just before a “T” intersection with a bridge crossing Crooked Creek. There is a lot of good trailer parking, but very little turn around room. The recommended approach to the camp ground is to drive just past the entrance and back your trailer into the camp.



There should be room for a number of trailers, but when possible let's trailer share. There are good places for tents and pickup campers. There are good locations for high lines and access to water.
