Squaw Butte Event Reservation System

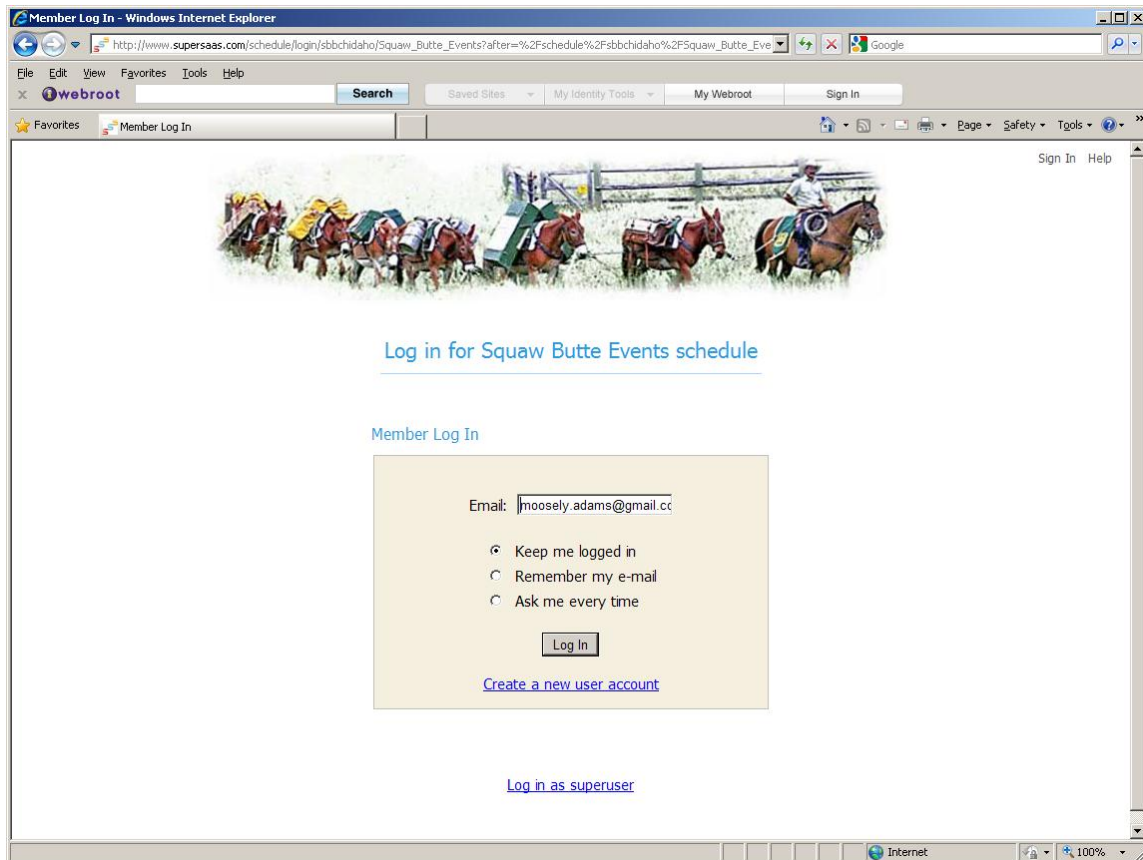



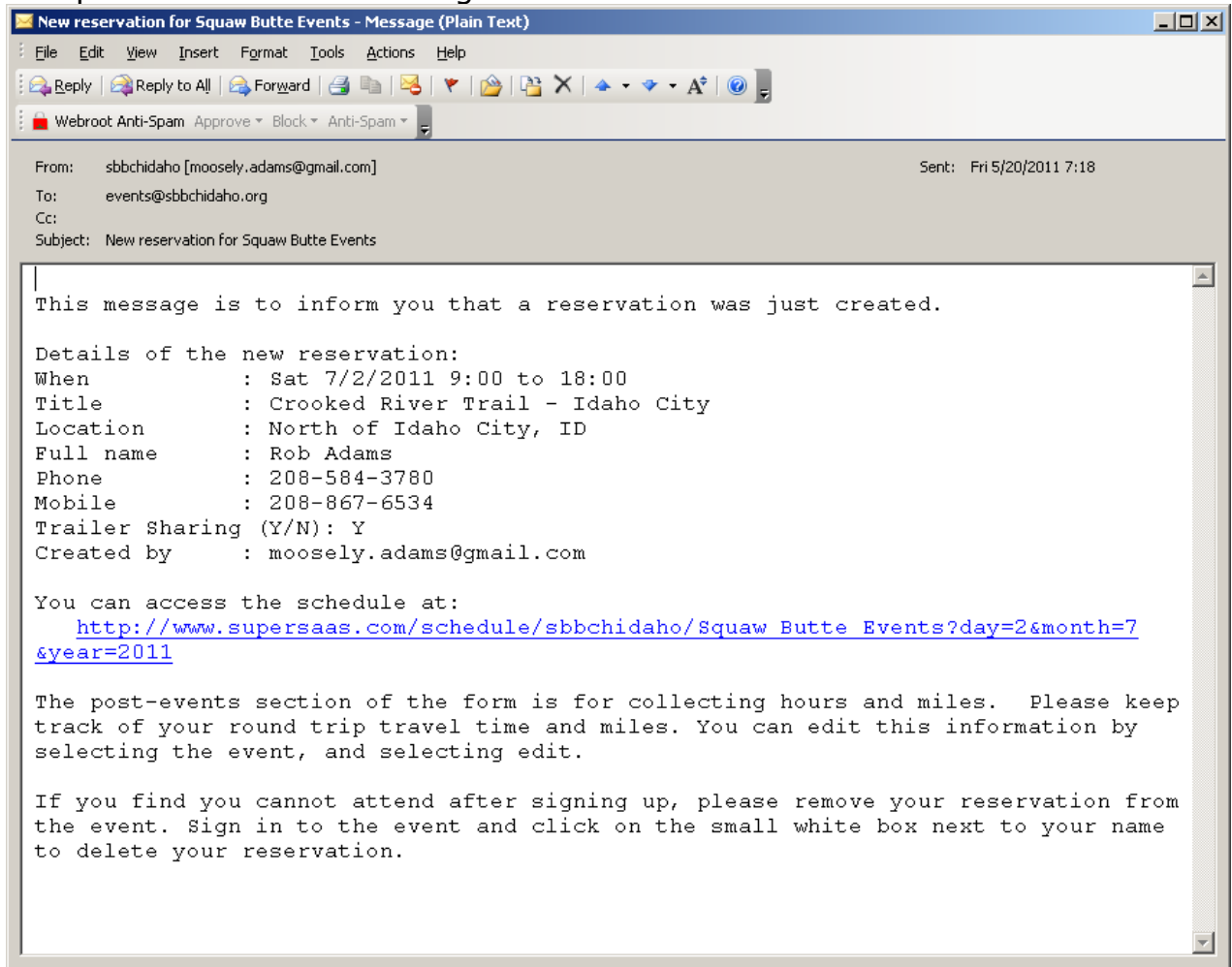
