General Information

This is a fee campground. Fee envelopes and a collection box are provided near the entrance. This area is accessible for a season that varies between April 20 to October 20 due to snow levels. Boiling Springs Campground is located north of Garden valley along the Middle Fork of the Payette River. It is just a short walk away from Boiling Springs geothermal hot springs.

Units have parking and can accommodate small to medium RV's up to a length of 30 feet. All units have tables, grills and fire pits. Artesian drinking water is available from one hand pump. One vault toilet is located within the campground.

National Recreation Reservation Service (NRRS): This campground is not part of the NRRS. Call 1-208-365-7000 for more information.

Travel: Boiling Springs is located in southwestern Idaho, 23 miles north of Garden Valley. Take National Forest Road 698 (NF-618) north from Crouch. Watch for recreation signs.

Fishing: The Idaho Department of Fish and Game manages the river fisheries. Fishing is good to excellent most of the year. Fishing occurs from the riverbanks. Whitefish and rainbow trout are the predominate species.

Hunting: Hunting is good on both sides of the river during the legal season. Big game (deer, elk & bear) hunting is best on the higher slopes throughout the surrounding mountains.

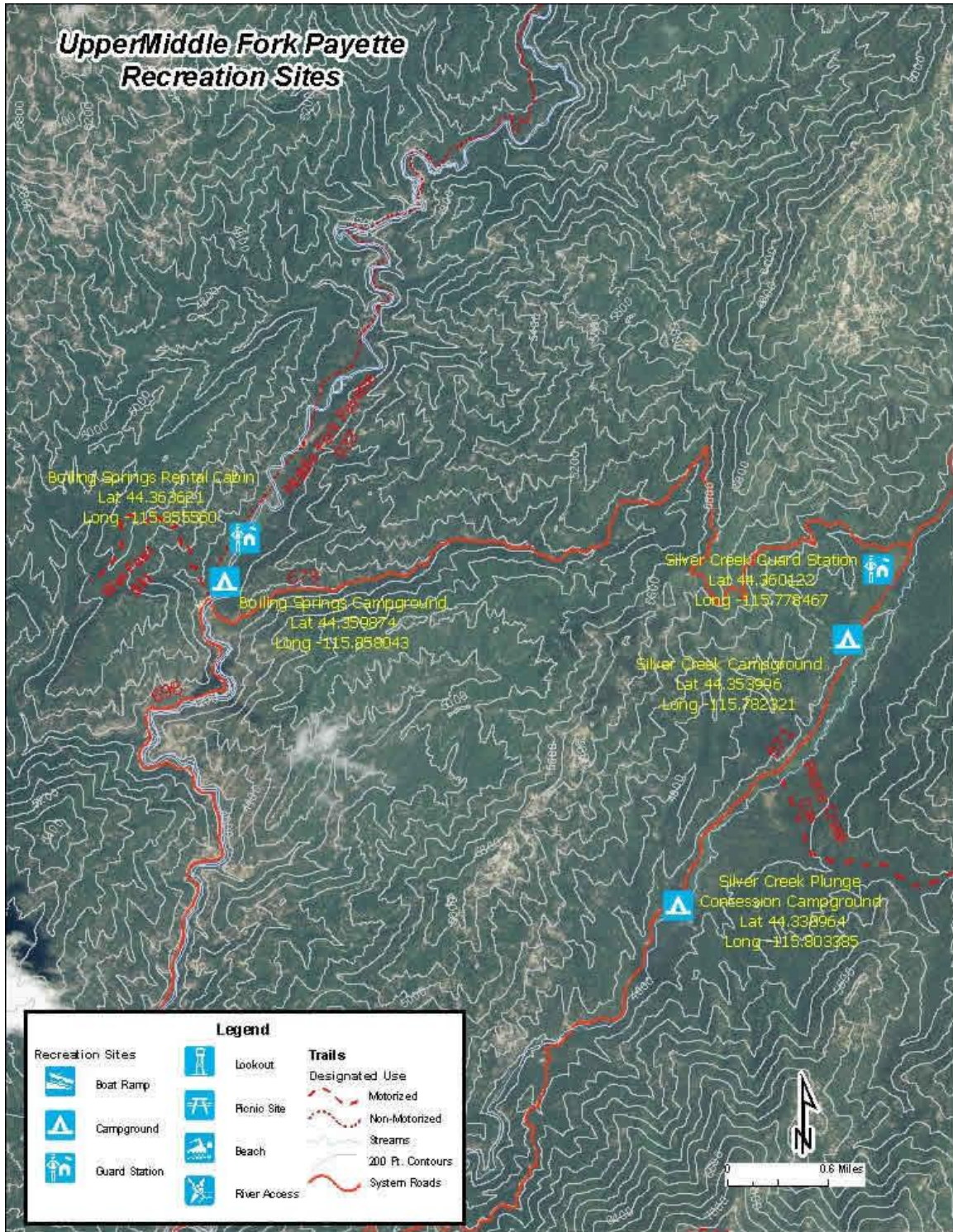
Boating: The Middle Fork Payette River can be boated with rafts or canoes during high flows but is too shallow for most of the season. Inner tubes and kayaks may be able to access the river during low water.

Recreation sites nearby: Boiling Springs Cabin, Silver Creek Campground, Silver Creek Guard Station

Trails: There are several trails located in easy reach of this campground. Most trails in this area are motorized. The Wetfoot Trail is open to motorized vehicles. The Middle

Fork Trail is non-motorized. Trails provide access to high mountain peaks and some hot springs. Some trails access the Landmark and Stolle Meadows areas.

Site Seeing: The area consists of high, forested mountains along the Middle Fork of the Payette River.
