Description: 6700-foot elevation. 8 campsites on the border of the Frank Church River of No Return Wilderness. Trail #021 leaves the campground to hike or horse ride north into the wilderness. Fishing for trout in Beaver Creek, in nearby Cape Horn lakes, and in the many alpine lakes found along the trail in the wilderness. Horse stalls with feeding stations are across the road, at the trailhead. Horse camp on the North Side of the road.

Location: From Stanley, go 19 miles northwest on ID 21, then 3 miles north on Forest Road 203 and FR 008.
