

Twenty Mile Trail #085

Area Status: Open



The Twenty Mile Trail is 18 miles north of McCall on Warren Wagon Road. There is a wooden trailhead sign on the road. A short dirt road to the right leads to the trailhead, which features a horse unloading ramp, hitching rails, and a toilet. There is a large parking area with enough room for trailers. There is a bulletin board with trail information. This trail is an easy hike for the first three miles before the trail splits. After that the trail to the right turns south for 8 miles and

connects with the Duck Lake Trail #085. The left branch (**North Lake/Twenty Mile Lakes Trail #315**) climbs steeply for another 2.9 miles into the high lakes area. Much of the area burned in the Blackwell and Corral wildfires of 1994 and the vegetation is regenerating nicely. The trail is open for the following uses: Hiking, Mountain Biking, Horseback Riding, Motorcycle Trail Riding

Directions: Travel north from McCall on Warren Wagon Road, past Upper Payette Lake. The Twenty Mile Trailhead is two miles north of the **Upper Payette Lake Campground** entrance, on the right side of the road. There is a short gravel road that leads to the trailhead.

The North Lake/Twenty Mile Lakes Trail is a 2.9 mile trail that leaves the **Twenty Mile Trail #085** 3 miles from the trailhead off Warren Wagon Road. The trailhead elevation is 5600' and the lakes are at 7800'. This is a good trail to see wildlife, especially deer. The fishing is excellent in the four very scenic Twenty Mile Lakes, but it's a recommended overnight trip for many hikers. The trail is open to the following uses: Hiking, Horseback Riding

Directions: Travel north 18 miles from McCall on Warren Wagon Road, past Upper Payette Lake. The Twenty Mile Trailhead is two miles north of the **Upper Payette Lake Campground** entrance, on the right side of the road. There is a short gravel road that leads to the trailhead. The North Lake/Twenty Mile Lakes Trail leaves the **Twenty Mile Trail #085** to the north after 3 miles of easy trail.

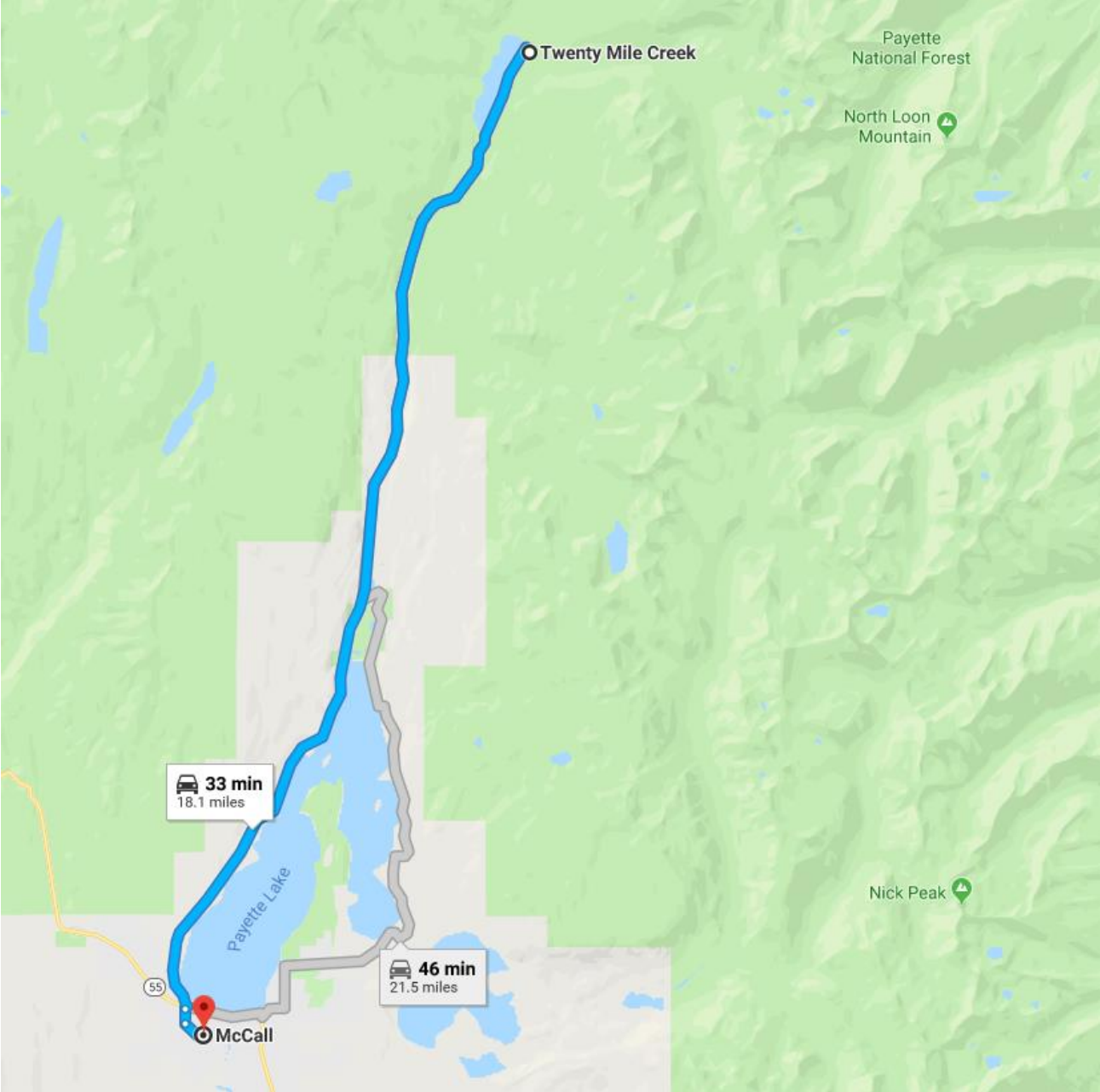
